1. General Classroom Procedures:

3. Homework:

- Homework is worth 3 points for each assignment that is correct, complete with work, and on-time.
- Corrections from class discussions should be shown on your assignments.
- The heading on homework should have the assignment number in the upper left corner and your name and folder number in the upper right corner.
- Late homework is given 1/3 credit.
- HOMEWORK (LATE OR ABSENT) IS NOT ACCEPTED AFTER THE UNIT TEST.

4. Notes:

- You will be taking notes almost every day; bring your Student Note Taking Guide.
- If you are absent, please copy the notes from another student or our Google Classroom.

5. Absences:

- You have until the day of the test to submit your assignments for full credit.

6. Extra Help:

- If you need extra help, I am usually available Tuesday through Friday mornings before school.

7. Tests:

- You are expected to be in class and ready to take tests on the scheduled days.
- The next test date is posted on the front board in the classroom.
- If you are absent on a test day, be prepared to take the exam on the day you return.
- Each test is worth 100 points; this comprises the largest part of your grade (70%).
- Test make-ups are given before school and during class.
- If you are truant or caught cheating, your test grade is zero.
- If you completed all the homework for a unit, you may complete remediation work and take a make-up exam to raise an "F" or "D" score to a "C-." You must make these arrangements with me.

8. Grades:

- Homework is 15% of your grade.
- Tests and quizzes are 70% of your grade.
