Each year DTASC hosts a Fall Festival

competition and a Spring Shakespeare competition. Different schools host each year, and Valencia has hosted twice. The competition has such events as the audition mono-Shakelogue, speare's Families, Shakespeare Humor, Shakespeare CSI, Shakespeare the Musical, a scene from King

Lear, and a scene from Much Ado about Nothing. These events were chosen during a June meeting by the drama teachers involved.

The group drama event involves three to six participants selecting and performing a serious scene from King Lear. There is a time limit of eight minutes.

The group comedy event is similar, but involves a comedic scene from Ado about Nothing instead. Much
